VAST SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION GUIDELINES AND APPLICATION FORM Summer Students

Eligibility:

- Currently enrolled in an undergraduate program at a Canadian university.
- Co-supervision by two PIs is required. Supervisor and co-supervisor must both be VAST co-investigators OR either the supervisor or co-supervisor may be eligible if they are both i) an early career researcher (< 5 years since first academic appointment), and ii) a registered VAST member contributing content development and/or mentoring students in the VAST mentorship program.
- Proposed project is related to vascular contributions to cognitive impairment and dementia.
 - Projects involving other neurodegenerative processes (e.g., Alzheimer's disease) are allowed as long as vascular dysfunction is being investigated as a process cause, modulator, or outcome.

Application deadline:

- Application will be submitted electronically via fillable PDF.
- Application deadline is February 1 for funding that begins in summer 2024.
- We aim to notify successful applicants by March 1, 2024.

The following materials are required (1 electronic copy in PDF format):

- 2-page PDF application. All sections are mandatory. The application includes:
 - Survey regarding equity, diversity, and inclusion (EDI).
 - **Other Funding**: Disclosure of other funding is required.
 - Applicant Statement of Intent.
 - Applicants will be evaluated on motivation, interest in the field, and how the application will help their training and further their career goals.
 - If you had previous VAST summer funding, please explain how this year's project will enhance your experience by providing you with new knowledge and skills.
 - **Project Summary**: Include a brief description of the objective, hypothesis, methods, and significance of the project. Clearly state the applicants' role in the project.
 - Evaluated based on the impact, novelty, and feasibility of the project.
 - **Supervisor and Co-Supervisor Description of Training Environment:** This section should be completed by the supervisors or with input from the supervisors.
 - Evaluated on support for the student and demonstrated access to the facilities, equipment, collaborative opportunities, and mentorship needed to successfully executive the project.
 - Supervisor and Co-Supervisor Expectations: It is required that VAST mentors will contribute (or have contributed) an online learning module (approved by the VAST curriculum committee) and agree to serve at a later date on the VAST stipend review committee if asked.
- Attachments: please include these in PDF format
 - University undergraduate transcript: can be unofficial.
 - Applicant CV.
 - Evaluated based on professional or volunteer experience including non-scientific positions; demonstrated interest in health and research; and diversity of life experiences.
 - **Supervisor and co-supervisor signed letter of support** (1 page maximum): Clearly delineate the student's role in project, student fit with project, and supervisor assessment of the student.
 - Evaluated based on relevance of the supervisor/co-supervisor collaboration to the project, and quality of the mentorship and training environment. The supervisor must describe a source of matching funds to provide student with minimum stipend of \$1500/month.

Funding: VAST will provide **up to \$750 per month** (50% support) for up to 4 months (4 weeks minimum), from May to August 2024. For students with additional sources of funding, the VAST Executive Committee reserves the right to reduce the VAST contribution.

Submission: Please complete the online EDI survey, and email the PDF application to Jolene Phelps, jolene.phelps@ucalgary.ca, by February 1, 2024. Note that the submission period may be extended if there is not adequate diversity among the applicants.

Evaluation: Competitive; ranked based on peer review.
